Part of this process includes the monthly review of various international, national and local regulatory update services. The review of European Union, USA and various country laws and regulations are covered under this practice. The EHS coordinators at the facilities are required to review federal, state and local laws and regulations for impact to their sites. The result of the reviews is anticipating new regulatory impacts and planning for their implementation. Information and analysis is shared with all EHS coordinators, who in turn must share these with their management team at the facility. Allergan actively engages in dialogue, comments on, and makes recommendations regarding new and revised legislation as well as new and revised regulations.
